Step into history

Our History

Oxnead Hall has roots stretching back to the 11th century. The Paston family who were one of Norfolk's most prominent families moved in during the 1420s. They are best known for the Paston Letters, a remarkable collection of personal correspondence that gives insight into English life during the medieval and Tudor periods.

The estate was once a grand complex of halls, gardens and waterways, and traces of that past can still be felt today, from the ancient stonework to

the peaceful on-site church that still hosts weddings.

When the Aspinall family took on the estate in 2011, they lovingly restored it, reviving the Hall, Barn and gardens, and bringing back its spirit as a place for celebration.

Today, all the bedrooms are named after Paston family members, and the whole estate tells a story - one that now includes yours.

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Envisage Your Wedding Day

Your day begins in the Preparation Room, tucked in the Courtyard opposite the Barn. It's a calm space to enjoy the morning with your closest people. When the time feels right, you'll head to the Honeymoon Suite to finish getting ready and step into your outfit of dreams before making your entrance.

You might choose to say 'I do' in the Parterre or Woodland, opt for an indoor ceremony in the Orangery or Fountain Room, or even marry in the on-site Church. Each space offers something unique.

Afterwards, guests enjoy drinks and canapés in the Parterre Gardens - in front of the Hall, beside the lake and river. The Orangery also offers a beautiful indoor setting for a drinks reception at any time of year.

The Great Barn hosts your wedding breakfast, followed by speeches, cake-cutting and your first dance. As evening falls, the barn becomes your celebration space, with dancing, late-night food, and the Honeymoon Suite just steps away.

Now married, your reception begins with drinks and canapés.



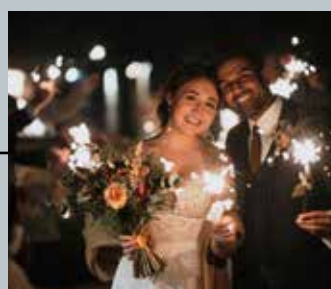
4:30 PM

The Preparation Room

From 10am, the Preparation Room is yours. Set in the Courtyard opposite the Barn, it's your own space to get dressed, make final touches, and soak up the excitement before the day begins.

You'll find everything you need - dressing tables, mirrors, a shower, tea and coffee, and a fridge ready for your own drinks and snacks. There's plenty of room for your party to get glammed up, fix ties, and ease into the day together.

Later on, once you're nearly ready, you'll head over to the Honeymoon Suite for those final touches before it's time to say "I do."





Your Ceremony



THE ORANGERY

(Seats up to 50 guests)

A beautiful light-filled space with views across the lawn and gardens. The Orangery feels calm and elegant, perfect for a smaller, romantic indoor ceremony.



THE FOUNTAIN ROOM

(Seats up to 140 guests)

Located beside the Courtyard, the Fountain Room is our largest indoor ceremony space. With its decorative backdrop and soft lighting, it's perfect for a stylish, indoor ceremony whatever the season.



THE PARTERRE GARDEN

(Seats up to 140 guests)

With original Tudor Parterre, a wide gravel aisle and views over the water, the Parterre sits in front of the Hall and offers a unique, elegant setting for an outdoor ceremony with real impact.



THE WOODLAND

(Seats up to 200 guests)

Peaceful and tucked away, our Woodland ceremony area is a natural, secluded spot surrounded by trees and open sky.



THE TREE-LINED AVENUE

(Seats up to 200 guests)

Often described as the aisle way of dreams, this beautifully private setting is framed by rows of trees leading to a striking stone feature at the water's edge.



THE ON-SITE CHURCH

(Seats up to 90 guests)

A short walk across the lawn, the on-site church offers a traditional setting full of history and character.



THE WATER GARDEN

(Seats up to 60 guests)

Set on its own island beyond the bridge, the Water Gardens offer a calm, tucked-away spot surrounded by trees and water.

Your First Celebration

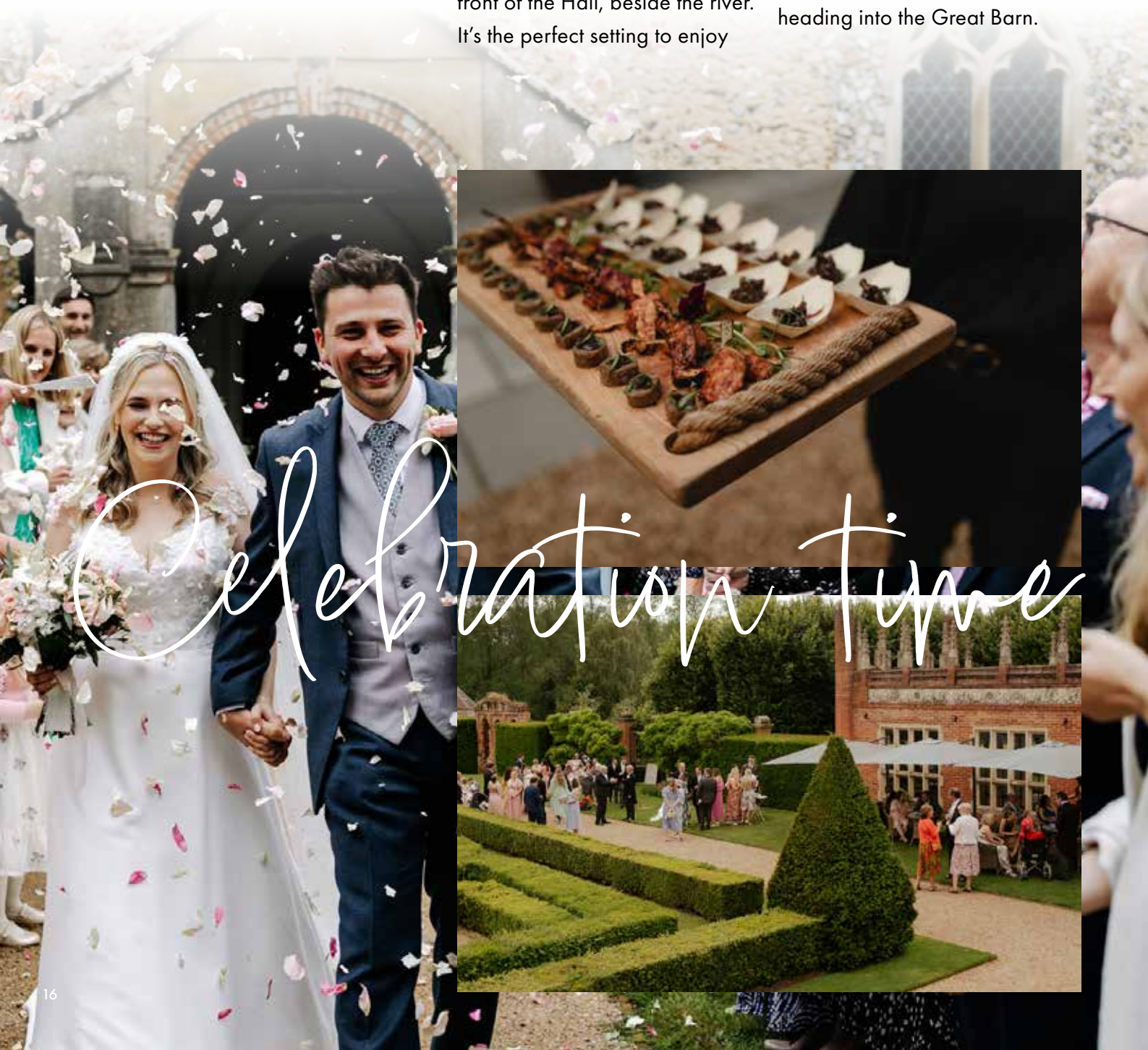
Once your ceremony is over, it's time to relax, raise a glass, and let the celebrations begin.

This is also a great time for your confetti moment. The Parterre arches are one of the most popular spots, though the tree-lined avenue, church front, or Fountain Courtyard all make beautiful backdrops too.

Your drinks reception takes place in the Parterre Gardens, just in front of the Hall, beside the river. It's the perfect setting to enjoy

canapés, lawn games, music, and those first few moments with your guests. If the weather's not on your side, the Orangery offers a sheltered option within the Parterre Garden itself, so you can still enjoy the view and atmosphere, just with a little more cover.

While your guests enjoy the reception, you'll have time to slip away for photos - or take a quiet moment together- before heading into the Great Barn.

The Orangery is ideal for very small weddings or mid-week ceremonies. With views of the Parterre and lake, and glass windows on all sides, it's a calm, elegant space to enjoy your first meal together in a beautiful setting.



THE FOUNTAIN ROOM

(Seats up to 60 guests)

For smaller weddings, the Fountain Room offers a relaxed and intimate setting, just off the Courtyard. It's a great choice if you're planning something more low-key but still want a beautiful space to celebrate.



THE BARN

(Seats up to 200 guests)

Most couples choose to dine in the Barn, It's spacious, flexible, and full of character. Whether you're imagining round tables, long banquet-style seating or a mix of both, we'll help you create a layout that works for you.

After drinks and photos, your guests will make their way into the Great Barn for the wedding breakfast.

The barn can seat up to 200 guests, but it works just as well for more intimate celebrations. Whether you picture long banquet tables, round layouts or something in between, the space can be styled to suit your day.

On the day itself, your UNV wedding team will be there to oversee the celebration - from arranging your dress or buttonholes to making sure the room is set and everything is exactly as it should be before you make your entrance.

Our role is simple: to take care of the details, so you can focus on what matters - enjoying the people and the day around you.







FAQ

THE PACKAGE

What is included in the package?

Your package includes the core elements of your wedding day as outlined in the package price list and confirmed at the time of booking. Any additional items or upgrades you choose to add during your planning, such as extra guests, menu or drinks enhancements, extended hire, additional staffing or accommodation extras, are priced in line with our current rates at the time they are requested and confirmed. Your wedding planning team will always confirm any additional costs with you before they are added to your invoice.

Do I have exclusive use of the venue?

Yes, you have exclusive use of the venue and grounds on the day of your wedding. Exclusive use timings depend on your chosen package, with access beginning from either 2pm or 4pm, and concluding at 12 midnight.

How many guests can this venue accommodate?

The Great Barn can host up to 200 guests for your ceremony and wedding breakfast, and up to 250 for your evening reception. The Fountain Room is ideal for a more intimate celebration, seating up to 140 for a ceremony and 60 for a wedding breakfast. The Orangery offers a charming setting for smaller gatherings, with space for up to 50 ceremony guests, 30 for a seated meal, and up to 99 for a drinks reception.

Is the venue licensed to hold Civil Ceremonies?

Yes, the venue is fully licensed to hold civil ceremonies, both indoors and outdoors. An additional cost applies for holding your ceremony at the venue; full details can be found in the pricing guide.

What time can I get married at this venue?

We recommend a 2pm ceremony for weddings booked with one night of accommodation. Earlier ceremony times may be available for an additional fee for couples staying the night before. Please check available ceremony times with your registrar, and our planning team will be happy to advise on your timeline and options. Full details are outlined in our pricing guide.

Are chairs provided for the ceremony?

Yes, chairs are provided as part of the package, but cannot be moved outside due to the requirement of a suitable backup in adverse weather. If you are having an outdoor ceremony, you will need to hire additional outdoor chairs separately which can be done through our wedding planning team.

What about music during the ceremony?

Many couples book musicians to provide music during their ceremony, however you are more than welcome to use the sound system already in the ceremony area. For outdoor ceremonies, please check with our wedding planning team if you are required to provide your own speaker. Any external speaker must be PAT tested.

Is there a local church?

Yes, there is a church within the grounds of Oxnead Hall. To find out more, contact;

Please note: As a historic building, the church is unheated and does not have bells. Ceremonies are available Monday to Saturday.

Will I have the same dedicated Wedding Coordinator throughout the planning process?

Every couple will have access to our central planning team from the very beginning, so there will always be someone to help guide you with questions or ideas anytime you reach out. Closer to your wedding date, you will then be assigned your designated wedding coordinator to ensure every last detail is managed on your big day!

Can we use any supplier?

Yes. We have available a recommended supplier list. Should you wish to work with suppliers not on our pre-approved list we require all suppliers' phone numbers, email addresses, and a copy of their public liability insurance before they can operate at our venue. If any supplier is using electrical equipment, PAT certificates must be provided in advance. By making a booking at our venue, we assume that you agree to these conditions.

Can we decorate the barn beams?

Yes, we have a list of recommended suppliers.

For insurance reasons, only our authorised suppliers can hang decorations at height.

What time can we access the venue for setting up?

Standard venue access for setting up is from 10am on the morning of your wedding day. If you would like access to the venue the day before your wedding for styling and set-up, this can be arranged between 12pm and 4pm for an optional day-before set-up fee. This applies whether or not you are staying in the accommodation the night before, unless a night-before accommodation supplement has already been applied.

Day-before access is confirmed at your final planning meeting, subject to availability. If day-before access is not arranged, your wedding coordinator will set out your decorations for you on the wedding day at no extra charge.

Is confetti allowed?

Yes, only natural or organic confetti is permitted. Unfortunately, no other type of confetti is allowed for use at the venue.

Are dogs allowed at the venue?

Yes, your dog can be on site for up to 1.5 hours. Your dog can join you in the ceremony areas and in the grounds during your reception. Your dog must always be kept on a lead. Under no circumstances can your dog be permitted in the accommodation or any unauthorised buildings. The wedding party is responsible for clearing up after your dog. Once your dog's visit concludes, provisions must be in place for timely collection of your dog. We have a list of recommended suppliers for drop off, pick up and overnight stay.

What time will the wedding end?

Last orders are at 11:45pm and the bar closes at midnight. Music will also finish at midnight. Please advise your guests to arrange their taxis or transportation in advance.

What about clearing up the next day?

There is no need to worry about this; our event team will clear everything and pack away your decorations for you, ready for collection the following day. A member of our team will also be there to greet you upon checkout at 10am to return your belongings.

Can we hire a projector and screen?

Yes, a projector and screen are available to hire for an additional cost. These can be added to your booking after speaking with our wedding planning team.

Can we hire Z-beds and Cots?

Yes, a limited number of Z-beds and cots are available to hire and can be arranged through the planning team.

OUTSIDE AREA

Is there seating outside?

Yes, there are chairs and tables in the outside area for your guests. If you require more seating options, you will need to hire this through an external supplier.

Can we have any outdoor games or bouncy castles?

Yes, you are welcome to have lawn games outside in permitted areas. Bouncy castles are not allowed at the venue. Please note our staff are unable to supervise any lawn games.

Is outdoor lighting allowed to be put up around the venue?

Yes, only if agreed before and provided by our recommended suppliers.

Can we put signs on the ground?

Yes, A-frame boards or easels can be used for signage. We cannot allow signs to be inserted into the ground due to preserving the gardens and entrances. All your signage must be removed when leaving Oxnead Hall.

Do you allow coaches?

Yes, mini-buses can be used, but must drop guests off at the top of the guest car park. Larger coaches can not be accommodated due to the lack of turning space available.

Are caravans or motorhomes allowed on site?

Caravans and motorhomes are not permitted to stay on site. Our planning team can recommend nearby campsites and accommodation for your guests.

Can we park?

There is parking at the venue providing ample spaces for guests. Cars may be left overnight, at the owner's risk, for collection the next morning by 10am latest.

Are we allowed to use drones?

Yes! Your photographer or videographer must have a licence to fly the drone and supply us with proof of their licence and insurance prior to the wedding.

Are fireworks allowed?

Out of consideration for our neighbours and surrounding wildlife, we do not allow fireworks.

CATERING

Can our menu be tailor made?

Yes, we will work with you to provide the perfect menu for your wedding day.

Is it possible to choose a couple of dishes?

We recommend that you choose one starter, one main course and one dessert. Please take a look in our catering brochure for choice menus and bespoke options.

Can you cater for our guests who are vegetarian, vegan or have food allergies?

Yes, allergen, vegan and vegetarian adapted menus are available to guests with dietary requirements at no extra charge.

Do you provide crockery?

Yes, white crockery, traditional silver cutlery, table linen and glassware are all included in the package. If you wish to upgrade your tableware, our wedding planning team also offers a hire brochure. Our brochure showcases an incredible range of crockery, cutlery, linen and glassware that can complement your wedding day.

I have a copy of an old catering brochure but would like a dish from the new menu, is that possible?

We regularly update our catering menus to reflect seasonal produce and new dish ideas. For this reason, we ask couples to select their menu from our most up-to-date catering brochure, which showcases our current dishes. If there is a dish from a previous brochure that you particularly loved, please mention this to our wedding planning team, who

will be happy to talk it through with you.

Can we bring our own caterers?

It is essential that we provide a consistently high standard of catering at our venue and therefore only allow our in-house experienced chefs on your wedding day, who offer an exceptionally high level of service using quality locally-sourced ingredients. We also do not allow any external caterer the night before or day after your wedding.

What table layout can we have?

There are a number of table layouts that work well for your wedding breakfast, and our wedding planning team will be happy to advise you on the best option for your day. Round tables are provided as standard. If you would prefer a long rectangle banqueting-style layout using trestle tables, these can be arranged through the planning team; an additional cost applies as they are hired in specially for your wedding. We do require you to complete a table plan and highlight any dietary requirements so the events team are able to locate guests easily on the day.

When do I need to provide my pre-orders?

We require all pre-orders and your final table plan to be with us six weeks before your event. Our wedding planning team will give you a blank table plan to fill in.

Can I bring my own alcohol?

You may bring your own wine, prosecco or champagne for your wedding day; however, there is no reduction to the package price. Any alcohol brought onto the premises is subject to a corkage charge, calculated per standard

75cl bottle, based on the number of bottles brought in rather than the amount consumed. Corkage cost can be found in our drinks menu. Alternatively, we offer an extensive wine list at competitive prices. You may also bring one 50ml alcoholic favour per person at no additional charge.

Do you take cash and card payments at your bar?

Our bars are card only, including Apple Pay and contactless. Cash is not accepted, please do advise your guests.

Should we provide our contractors with a meal?

We recommend that you provide any suppliers spending more than five hours at your wedding with a meal. Most suppliers will also outline their requirements for food and drink in their booking contract.

Can we make any changes to the package?

You can add on to the package but cannot remove any items. You can only increase the amount of guests; our price list outlines the minimum amount of guests you will pay for.

What is involved in the tasting event?

We believe it is important for you to sample our menu ahead of your wedding day. Tasting events are included for couples who have booked our Ultimate Wedding Package only and are hosted as group tasting events, where multiple couples join us to experience the food, service and presentation as it would be delivered on the day. Private one-to-one tastings are not offered, as these do not accurately reflect the experience you would enjoy at your wedding. If your wedding is booked with less than nine months to go, we may not be able to offer

a tasting; however, our Head Chef is available to speak with if needed.

What is on the menu for the tasting event?

This is chosen months in advance and it is our chef's choice from the Original and the Premium menus. Please see more details of the event in our catering brochure.

What constitutes a child?

A child is a guest aged 3–11 years. A young adult is a guest aged 12–17 years. Guests aged 18 and over are charged at the full adult rate.

What menu is available for children/young adults?

Children are served dishes from our children's menu. Young adults receive the same menu as the adult guests, with dishes served as an adult portion. Menu inclusions vary depending on your chosen wedding package. Full details can be found in our Catering Brochure, and your wedding planning team will be happy to guide you through the options.

Can I bring my own food to our wedding?

You're welcome to bring in wedding cakes, sweets, and favours on place settings. We do not allow you to bring any other food on site for your wedding. If you are providing anything that is not covered by a supplier's insurance, you will be required to sign a waiver form. Please note we do not allow nuts on site.

If you're staying the night before, you may bring your own food, and use the accommodation kitchens facilities.

MUSIC

Are there any restrictions on evening music?

In accordance with our entertainment licence, a sound limiter is installed inside the venue and is set at 90 decibels. Please ensure that any external contractors are aware of this and that they have confirmed to you that they can and will play through the system and the electric drum kit provided by Oxnead Hall. Please note that a booking at the venue assumes that you have agreed to this condition.

Is music permitted outside?

Yes, music (acoustic or from a speaker) is permitted until 5pm. The volume is controlled by staff. Amplified music is not allowed outside.

Where is evening music permitted?

Evening music is only permitted inside in the evening reception space.

Are we allowed smoke, fog or dry ice machines?

Smoke, fog or dry ice machines are not permitted at the venue. Please inform your chosen band or DJ of this when confirming your booking.

ACCOMMODATION

Do you have to take all of the accommodation on-site at the venue?

All wedding accommodation must be taken as part of your booking, dependent on the accommodation package selected. It's priced separately from the main wedding packages, and full details are in our accommodation price list.

Is a damage deposit required on the accommodation?

Yes. A deposit of £995 is required, which is added to your quote and will be refunded within 14 days of the wedding providing there is no damage to the site.

What time is check-in and check-out?

The accommodation is available for your guests to check in from 3pm. Checkout is by 10am the following day. Please note extra charges may apply if you check out late.

Do you offer early check in or late check out?

Early check-in and late check-out are subject to availability and cannot always be guaranteed. Requests are discussed at the final planning meeting, with late check-out available up to 12pm where possible. An additional cost applies; please refer to the Pricing Guide for details.

Can we stay in the accommodation the night before our wedding?

Yes, subject to availability, it is possible to book the accommodation for the night before your wedding. Full details and pricing are outlined in our pricing guide.

ACCESSIBILITY

Does this venue have wheelchair access?

We have a number of accessibility features in place to ensure the comfort and safety of all guests that visit the site, including those using a wheelchair.

How is the full payment broken down?

The full payment is broken down into the following steps:

- ✓ £500 initial payment.
- ✓ £1,250 payment within 6 weeks of booking.
- ✓ £1,000 payment 12 months prior to your wedding date.
- ✓ £1,500 payment 6 months prior to your wedding date.

Remaining balance is due one month prior to wedding date.

Please note this payment schedule will be amended accordingly if booking with less than 12 months until the wedding date.
